1. Introduction to the course

General Goal:

Familiarizing students with the concepts and examples of passive defense and its consequences

In this lesson, learners with the concept and examples of passive defense and the role of nurses in it and relying on their learnings will plan and train in the form of one of the nursing models in order to prevent, care, treat and rehabilitate the victims of these disasters and their families.

Course Objectives:

At the end of the course, the student should be able to:

1. Familiarize yourself with the role and application of nursing models in the face of passive defense.
2. Be familiar with the weapons and biological agents used in war or terrorist attacks.
3. Explain the types of microbial (anthrax, botulism, plague and pseudo-plague) and viral agents (chickenpox, influenza, hemorrhagic fevers lassa, Marburg, ebola, and argentine used in terrorist attacks)
4. Describe chemical agents and their types (cyanides, neurological, respiratory, blood, and typhoid agents) and explain how to prevent and disinfect them.
5. Describe radioactive and nuclear agents and how to prevent contamination and take measures at the time of contamination
6. Describe climate interventions and the HARP phenomenon.
7. Describe how to manage chemical, nuclear, and microbial care through collaboration within the team.
8. Describe the role and position of the nurse in passive defense.
